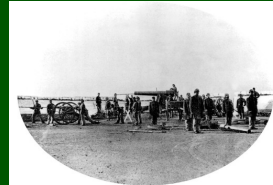

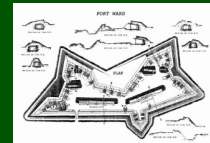

- Special preservation projects on earthworks

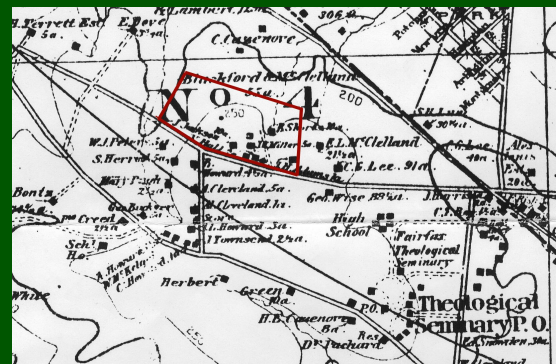


## Fort Ward Historic Site Improvements 2007-2009

- Replacement of rotted steps in bastion
- Painting and wood repair of Museum buildings
- Upcoming renovation of Fort Ward ceremonial gate
